FORM AND DESIGN FEATURES

LT-19930128-GDJ is a segmented wood vessel, sculpted with multiple compound shape transitions on a lathe. A transition in form occurs between the concave cylinder-shaped neck and the convex sphere-shaped body. A continuous transition in form occurs between the sphere-shaped body and disk-shaped base. The visible geometric motifs are formed with contrasting wood species that are integral to the walls of the vessel, and include: two sets of parallel lines, a band of alternating light-dark tiles, and a band of stepped bars.
