FORM AND DESIGN FEATURES

LT-19930216-GDJ is a segmented wood vessel, sculpted with multiple compound shape transitions on a lathe. A delineated form transition occurs between the cylinder-shaped neck and sphere-shaped body, and a continuous transition in form occurs between the sphere-shaped body and disk-shaped base. The visible geometric motifs are formed with contrasting wood species that are integral to the walls of the vessel, and include: a band of small stepped bars, and a concho belt of overlapping ovals, parallel lines, and human figures.
