FORM AND DESIGN FEATURES

LT-19930316-GDJ is a segmented wood vessel, sculpted with multiple compound shape transitions on a lathe. An overlapping transition in form occurs between the concave cylinder-shaped neck and sphere-shaped body, and a continuous transition in form occurs between the sphere-shaped body and disk-shaped base. The visible geometric motifs are formed with contrasting wood species that are integral to the walls of the vessel, and include: one pair of parallel lines with a linear band of alternating light-dark tiles, and a labyrinth band of alternating light-dark tiles.
