



FORM AND DESIGN FEATURES

LT-20091225-GDJ is a wood vessel hand-shaped and sculpted with hand tools on a lathe from a chunk of solid wood harvested directly from a dying tree. A continuous transition in form occurs between the convex sphere-shaped body and the concave cylinder-shaped stem, with another continuous transition occurring between the stem and the disk-shaped base. The naturally-occurring features of the original wood stock are visible and integral organic ornament to the walls of this wooden vessel.
