



## **FORM AND DESIGN FEATURES**

LT-20220720-WHJ is a lidded wood vessel hand-shaped and sculpted on a lathe. The body was formed and hollowed-out from a chunk of solid wood harvested from a tree. The lid was formed from a mosaic, multi-species turning blank, which included wood from the same tree. The form of this vessel is without historical reference to earlier pottery forms, and is thus Modern in form. The visible organic patterns of wood grain are integral to the walls of this wooden vessel. A continuous transition occurs between the indented, convex, and concave portions of the handle, stem, and top of the lid. A continuous convex transition is maintained between the lid of the vessel and its body. Stepped transitions occur along the upper wall of the body. An abrupt transition occurs where the convex lower wall meets the base.
